

Public Disclosure: Cincinnati Christian University Voluntary Resignation of Accreditation Effective: January 31, 2020

Cincinnati Christian University in Cincinnati, Ohio, voluntarily resigned accreditation with the Higher Learning Commission effective January 31, 2020, when the university ceased academic operations.
