

Public Disclosure: Cardinal Stritch University Voluntary Resignation of Accreditation Effective: November 30, 2023

Cardinal Stritch University in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, voluntarily resigned its accreditation with the Higher Learning Commission, effective November 30, 2023.

Its status as an HLC-accredited institution expires on the effective date above. Credits and degrees earned through this date from the institution remain accredited.

All student transcripts have been transferred to the Wisconsin Association of Independent Colleges and Universities (WAICU).
