



Public Disclosure: Ohio Valley University Voluntary Resignation of Accreditation Updated December 11, 2023

Ohio Valley University in Vienna, West Virginia, voluntarily resigned its accreditation with the Higher Learning Commission effective June 30, 2022, following the institution's closure.
