Dear President Klippenstein:

This letter serves as formal notification and official record of action taken concerning Mohave Community College (the institution) by the Institutional Actions Council (IAC) of the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) at its meeting on October 9, 2023. The date of this action constitutes the effective date of the institution's new status with HLC.

Action with Interim Monitoring. IAC continued the accreditation of Mohave Community College with the next Reaffirmation of Accreditation in 2032-33. In conjunction with this action, IAC required the following interim monitoring.

Interim Report. An Interim Report due 6/30/2025 on 4.B with details of progress in:

- defining academic and co-curricular programs
- articulating PLO's key assessments methods and thresholds for successful achievement of PLOs
- evidencing student learning in academic, general education, and co-curricular programs
- evidence that the data collected and analyzed is used to make improvements, and
- the development and implementation of a formalized, systematic, and integrated process(es) for academic and co-curricular assessments.

Embedded Monitoring Report. Embedded monitoring on 5.C in the institution's next Year 4 Assurance Review in 2026-27.

In taking this action, the IAC considered materials from the most recent evaluation and the institutional response (if applicable) to the evaluation findings.

Rationale: The IAC updated the details of the monitoring report on assessment to better align with the deficiencies identified by the HLC visiting team and with the subsequent reporting requirement by the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology (JRCERT) on student learning outcomes.

In two weeks, this action will be added to the *Institutional Status and Requirements (ISR) Report*, a resource for the institution to review and manage information regarding its accreditation relationship. Chief Executive Officers and Accreditation Liaison Officers may download the ISR Report in Canopy at <https://canopy.hlcommission.org>.
