

## Public Disclosure: Iowa Wesleyan University Voluntary Resignation of Accreditation Effective: May 31, 2023

Iowa Wesleyan University in Mount Pleasant, Iowa, has voluntarily resigned its accreditation with the Higher Learning Commission, effective May 31, 2023.
