

Public Disclosure: Presentation College Voluntary Resignation of Accreditation Effective: December 31, 2023

Presentation College in Aberdeen, South Dakota, voluntarily resigned its accreditation with the Higher Learning Commission, effective December 31, 2023, due to its announced closure.
