



**Public Disclosure:  
Arkansas Baptist College status changed  
from “Accredited – On Probation” to “Accredited”  
Effective: February 25, 2022**

The Higher Learning Commission has removed the Sanction of Probation for Arkansas Baptist College in Little Rock, Arkansas.

HLC took this action based on the institution’s ability to demonstrate that it is in compliance with HLC requirements. It was placed on Probation in February 2019 when it was determined to be out of compliance with HLC requirements.
