



**Public Disclosure:
Bacone College status changed
from “Accredited – On Probation” to “Accredited”
Effective: February 25, 2022**

The Higher Learning Commission has removed the sanction of Probation for Bacone College in Muskogee, Oklahoma.

HLC took this action based on the institution’s ability to demonstrate it now meets HLC’s Criteria for Accreditation, but with concerns, Criterion Four, Core Component 4.A (ensuring quality of educational offerings), Criterion Four, Core Component 4.B (assessment of student learning) and Criterion Five, Core Component 5.B (resource base).

The institution is required to submit an Interim Report on Core Components 4.A, 4.B and 5.B no later than February 2023. The next Comprehensive Evaluation for Reaffirmation of Accreditation will be in 2025-26.
