

**Public Disclosure:  
Wheeling University status changed  
from “Accredited – Probation” to “Accredited”  
Effective: February 23, 2023**

The Higher Learning Commission has removed the sanction of Probation for Wheeling University in Wheeling, West Virginia.

HLC took this action based on the institution’s ability to demonstrate that it is in compliance with HLC requirements. It was placed on Probation in February 2021 when it was determined to be out of compliance with HLC requirements.
