from “Accredited – Probation” to “Accredited”
Effective: November 4, 2021

The Higher Learning Commission has removed the sanction of Probation for Wilberforce University in Wilberforce, Ohio.

HLC took this action based on the institution’s ability to demonstrate it now meets HLC's Criteria for Accreditation. It was placed on Probation in June 2018 when it was determined to be out of compliance with HLC’s Criteria for Accreditation and was granted an extension based on HLC's temporary emergency COVID-19 policy.
