Dear Interim CEO Taylor-Ide:

As you know, Future Generations University (the institution) recently participated in an Institutional Actions Council (IAC) hearing on December 1, 2025. This hearing followed from action taken at an IAC meeting on August 11, 2025, in which the IAC Meeting Committee referred the institution to an IAC Hearing Committee for further review.

Attached is the IAC Hearing Committee's report related to its action from December 1, 2025 regarding the institution. The date of this action constitutes the effective date of the institution's new status with HLC.

Action with Interim Monitoring. The IAC continued and reaffirmed the accreditation of Future Generations University with the next reaffirmation of accreditation in 2035-2036. In conjunction with this action, IAC required the following interim monitoring.

Focused Visit. A focused visit on Core Components 4.A, program review, 4.B, assessment of student learning, 4.C, persistence, retention and completion outcomes, and 5.A, effective governance and administrative structures, by 12/15/27.

Further, IAC voted to change the team's evaluation of Core Components 2.B, 2.C, and 3.D from "Met with Concerns" to "Met" with no monitoring required.

Further details regarding the interim reports and the rationale for the IAC Hearing Committee's determinations are available in the attached hearing report.

In taking this action, the IAC considered materials from the most recent evaluation, the institutional response to the team report, and information provided by the institution and the team chair at the IAC hearing.

Please note: Revisions to HLC's Criteria for Accreditation and Assumed Practices went into effect on September 1, 2025. Institutions will be evaluated against these revised HLC requirements for all reviews conducted after this date, including reviews related to monitoring that was originally recommended based on the previous Criteria. Institutional reports submitted on or after September 1, 2025, or institutional reports or Assurance Arguments for visits that will take place on or after September 1, 2025, should be written to the revised version of the Criteria or Assumed Practices as applicable. In a week, this action will be added to the Institutional Status and Requirements (ISR) Report, a resource for the institution to review and manage information regarding its accreditation relationship.
