Effective: September 1, 2024

American Academy of Art College in Chicago, Illinois, voluntarily resigned its accreditation with the Higher Learning Commission effective September 1, 2024.

The institution's status as an HLC accredited institution expired on the effective date above. Credits and degrees earned from the institution through this date remain accredited.
