Martin University Voluntary Resignation of Accreditation

Effective: December 31, 2025

Martin University in Indianapolis, Indiana, voluntarily resigned its accreditation with the Higher Learning Commission effective December 31, 2025.

The institution's status as an HLC-accredited institution will change to the status of "inactive," meaning that the institution is no longer accredited on the effective date above.

What This Means for Students

Credits and degrees earned from the institution prior to the effective date above remain accredited.

In most cases, other colleges and universities will continue to accept credits earned from the institution prior to the effective date above in transfer or for admission to a higher degree program. All colleges and universities define their own transfer and admission policies. Students interested in pursuing a higher degree or transferring should contact the college or university they plan to attend so that they are knowledgeable about the admission and transfer policies for that college.

The institution has established a teach-out agreement that has been approved by HLC with University of Indianapolis in Indianapolis, Indiana.

The institution has indicated that transcripts will be available via [Parchment](#).

Students with federal loans may be eligible to pursue a [closed school student loan discharge](#).
